Rosie has been an active student in the Goofin Around Keyboard classes since January 2017 and has developed many lifelong friends. She still remembers that first time she was introduced to the classes.

"Cindy brought some of the students to Orchard Park Senior Center to play Christmas music while we had our Christmas Luncheon," Rosie recounted. "They offered door prizes, and two of those prizes were gift certificates to join the Goofin' classes. I was impressed with the music and thought, 'I sure would love to do that.' I was so hoping they would draw my name."



Physical & Mental Benefits of Music

Listening to or making music triggers the release of dopamine, the "feel good" brain chemical that makes us feel pleasure and enjoyment. This is most beneficial when we select music that we enjoy: songs from our youth, a genre we like, or songs of faith.

Sound processing (listening) begins in the brainstem, which also controls the heart rate, respiration rate, and blood pressure. Therefore, music can affect us physically! Studies have shown that listening to or playing music can:

- ease pain, stress, anxiety, depression
- help reduce pain and anxiety as patients recover from surgery
- enable people to exercise more effectively and longer
- improve blood vessel function by relaxing arteries
- aid speech recovery in stroke survivors by singing
- steady the gait of stroke and Parkinson's patients
